

## **DUGOUT SAFETY PROTOCOLS**

- 1. Coaches and players must not exit their vehicle until the start of their allotted practice time.
- 2. Coaches and players must immediately exit the facility once their practice time is completed.
- 3. COVID-19 Safety Manager is the only one permitted before and after practice in order to confirm safety protocols have been met.
- 4. No parents permitted in the Dugout at any time unless assigned as COVID-19 Safety Manager.
- 5. Coaches and Players are required to wear a mask or face covering in a manner that covers their mouth, nose and chin during any period when they are in the Dugout.
- 6. You must sanitize your hands when you arrive and when you depart the Dugout.
- 7. Players must place gear on the red X when entering.
- 8. Coaches must bring their own team balls to every practice. Balls can also be fogged at the end of practice.
- 9. Water bottles are permitted and must be labelled and filled prior to entering the dugout. No sport drinks, coffee or soda is permitted.
- 10. Coaches and Players must adhere to Public Health guidelines; Social distancing, 2 meters at all time.
- 11. Coaches, Players and Safety Manager must complete the TeamSnap online Health Check prior to entering the Dugout. If incomplete you will not be permitted to enter.
- 12. All equipment including fitness gear, nets, bases, rubber mounds, pylons must be returned to their proper location.
- 13. Coach or COVID-19 Safety Manager MUST fog The Dugout as per the posted training video.
- 14. Coach or COVID-19 Safety Manager must wipe down both the inside and outside door handles prior to exiting (use wipes provided).
- 15. Coaches and Players living outside of Halton must adhere to Public Health Guidelines within their Region. Higher levels of restrictions may prevent access to the Dugout.
- 16. Coaches or players who test positive for Covid-19 and have accessed the Dugout in the last 72 hours MUST contact Heidi Dombek <a href="https://high.nih.goo.nim.nih.goo.nim.goo.ni
- 17. If a Coach, player or Safety Manager becomes ill during their allotted time they must leave the Dugout immediately and notify Heidi Dombek and Mark O'Connor
- 18. Failure to follow COVID Safety Protocols by a team will result in the loss of two (2) practices at the Dugout.
